


## Creating Email Accounts- DotNetPanel

This guide will take you through the steps of setting up a website and a domain for your account in DotNetPanel. You'll be shown how to create a website and add a domain alias to it.

1. The first step is to log into the DotNetPanel. Visit <https://cp.eurofasthost.com/> using your web browser- whether that is Internet Explorer or Firefox.
2. Type in your login information you were provided by your welcome email. Your username will generally be your domain. If you forgot your password you can use our *"Forgot your password"* link on the front page.



3. Once logged in you will be greeted by our Account Home page. In the center of this page there will be a link with your domain name on it- click it.
4. Before creating the website you'll need to set up a domain. Click the "Domains" option on the left hand menu and select "Add Domain". The next screen will give you the option of creating a Domain, Subdomain or Domain Alias. Click the option for a "Domain".

5. Type your full domain name in the box provided, ticking the box to “Create a Web Site” and “Enable DNS”. If require, click the box to “Create Instant Alias”. The Instant Alias creates a temporary URL to access your website if you’re waiting for the name-servers to change or DNS to update.

**Provisioning Options**

- Create Web Site**  
Create a new web site and park this domain to the created web site.
- Enable DNS**  
Tick this checkbox if DNS zone for this domain will be located on name servers of your hosting provider. Make sure you changed name servers in the domain registrar control panel.
- Create Instant Alias**  
Tick this checkbox if you need to access your web site or mailboxes before DNS propagation takes places. DNS propagation is the time required to spread the information about DNS zone all over the Internet. It could take up to 72 hours.

6. This will create the website once the page has loaded. If you don't have any other domains, that's all you need to do!
7. If you do have additional domains that need to be pointed to this website, you'll need to add a Domain Alias. On the “Domains” page, click “Add Domain” again, this time selecting “Domain Alias”.
8. Type the domain in the box provide, and select the option to “Point to existing Web Site” and “Point to existing Mail Domain”. Select the website you want the alias to point to from the drop down menu. Ensure the box to “Enable DNS” is ticked.
9. You're done! You're website has now been added and you can create an FTP account to upload files.
