

Creating your email account in Windows Live Mail

This guide will take you through the steps of creating your email account in Windows Live Mail. For those that just need the details, please see below:

- Your Name: Your Name
- Email Address: yourname@yourdomain.com
- Incoming Server: mail.yourdomain.com
- Outgoing Server: mail.yourdomain.com
- Requires SMTP authentication

1. Open Windows Live Mail and wait for the prompt to "Add an E-mail Account". Enter your email address, password and display name. Click Next.

2. On the next page, ensure that *POP3* is selected and type **mail.yourdomain.com** in the *Incoming Server*. Change your login ID to your full email address.
